



MIXED BUILDING & DEMOLITION WASTE

Including brick, concrete, asphalt, gyprock, timber, rubble, tiles, insulation batts, air-conditioning panels, freezer/cooler panels, plasterboard.



DRY HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Including glass, plastic, plasterboard, household appliances, furniture, carpet. Fully cured and dried residues from glues, paints, coatings and inks.



HOUSEHOLD / EDUCATIONAL PREMISES (ONLY) CONTAMINATED WITH LEAD

Including interior and exterior paint in buildings built before 1970. Lead dust accumulated in ceiling cavities, carpet or furniture before 1980, lead water pipes, lead sheeting and lead light windows.



DRAINED / EMPTY OIL CONTAINERS

All oil containers must be empty before tipping. Any containers that are not fully empty will be returned to the customer and removed from site.



TREATED & UNTREATED TIMBER

May contain any of the following timber: medium density fibreboard, laminate, CCA treated timber, engineered timber, creosote treated timber, pallets, plywood etc. Must not contain any vegetation.



ASBESTOS WASTE

All types of asbestos waste are accepted including bonded, ACM soils and friable asbestos. Test reports will be required for large soil quantities prior to the commencement of tipping.



DANGEROUS GOODS CONTAINERS

All residue must be removed prior to site entry. Containers that have contained flammable liquids, organic pesticides, explosives etc. may need to be accompanied by a test report prior to tipping.



VIRGIN EXCAVATED NATURAL MATERIAL

VENM can be classified as soil, shale, sandstone or rock. VENM material must not contain any manmade materials whatsoever. Test reports apply for large quantities.



STORM MANAGEMENT WASTE

This may include any waste generated from storm water drains and catchments, Councils and private industry street sweepings, grit and/or sediment that may contain litter.



CURED CONCRETE BATCH PLANT WASTE

Dry / cured concrete from commercial concrete manufacturers.



GENERAL SOLID WASTE SOILS

General Solid Waste (non-putrescible). Soil that is classified as general solid waste must carry the relevant test reports. These reports must be submitted prior to the commencement of tipping.



HEAVY CLAY CONTAINING WASTE

Heavy waste containing man-made rubbish can no longer be classified as VENM. Test reports apply to large soil quantities.



COMMERCIAL & INDUSTRIAL WASTE

Light dry waste only. Consisting of co-mingled loads of timber, cardboard, plastics, paper, textiles, glass.



SYNTHETIC FIBER/EXPANDED PLASTICS

This waste includes: fiberglass, polyester, plastics, polystyrene etc. Note: any load that is greater by volume than 20% will incur a rate of \$1500/T.
